Bears Azure a chevron betwixt two mascles in cheefe and base soil slipped in base
within a bordure waved argent, with helmet and mantling as is usuall. Crest
a column or pillar sett in the Sea proper The motto In discrimine salus.

George Turnbull of Currie Bears argent a garb proper betwixt three 21
bulls heads erased sable, armed vert with helmet and mantling as is usuall. Crest
a dexter hand issuing out of a wreath holding up a basket's pyle charged with
three loaves in pale, argent within two branches of palm vert The motto SWEET
fortuna labori. Eupham Adinstone his spouse who was brother daughter
to Richard Adinstone of that ilk, bears Argent a cross engrailed sable
betwixt four cross crosslets fitchie gules a crescent for difference

James Turnbull of Currie bears the same. Mr. Peter Turnbull, Master at Law in 22
Edinburgh, and Clerk of the Court, bears Argent a chevron betwixt two mascles in cheefe
and base soil slipped in base within a bordure waved argent, with helmet and mantling
as is usuall. Crest a column or pillar sett in the Sea proper The motto In discrimine salus.
